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Budget for FY2122

Wingello Camping ground – request for support for Grant Funding

The recent support for grant funding for the Wingello Campground provided by the LRC. from the NSW Bushfire Local Economic Recovery Fund was unsuccessful, over 650 applications, totalling \$1.6B, were received which easily exceeded the allocated funding of \$250M

2022 4WD Spectacular

"Given the current risks associated with Covid 19 and State lock-downs, and the uncertainty surrounding the running of the event, the organising clubs have made the difficult decision to cancel the 2022 4WD Spectacular. While disappointed, we feel that this is the most responsible course of action at this time."
